Experience signature encounters featuring a focus on Proboscis Monkeys, wildlife sightings, a mangrove kayak tour, rare flora and fauna, and educational programmes through the efforts led by our Resident Naturalist.

The below itinerary functions as an example, and the two-day schedule of activities will only be confirmed at the resort after making arrangements with our Resident Naturalist.

Tentative itinerary for 7 Wonders of Gaya:

Day 1

8.00am: Mangrove kayaking in the morning | DURATION 1 hour - *Tide charts are checked daily to ensure the best time for activities.* We will be able to provide the optimum time between 8.00am and 11.00am upon booking.

12.30pm: Boat ride to Tavajun Bay to visit the Bearded Pigs and have lunch | DURATION 1 hour 30 minutes

4.00pm: Visit the firefly's habitat restoration, mangrove nursery and Elephant Foot Yam | DURATION 1 hour

Day 2

8.00am: Meet our Resident Naturalist at the reception and depart to the Proboscis Monkey platform | DURATION 2 hours

10:30am onwards: Free and easy

6:30pm: Meet at the wildlife centre in-search of Red Giant Flying Squirrel, and head off on the Night Walk in search of the nocturnal wonders and fireflies. | DURATION 2 hours

Inclusions: Lunch at Tavajun Bay, mineral water, binoculars, mosquito repellent and digital images of your experience via e-mail.

CORAL GARDEN SNORKELLING

Another wondrous world lies beneath the gentle waves of Tunku Abdul Rahman Marine Park. Explore the clear waters of the marine park guided by our Resident Marine Biologist.
