## CORAL GARDEN MARINE EXPEDITION

Another wondrous world lies beneath the gentle waves of Tunku Abdul Rahman Marine Park. Explore the clear waters of the marine park guided by our Resident Marine Biologist. Drift over lush coral gardens and discover the wealth of marine life amidst an array of hard and soft coral that form intricate and fragile labyrinths across the seabed. *Inclusions: Guided tour by resident marine biologist, briefing on safety and snorkelling techniques, marine identification slate, fins, mask and snorkel, a debriefing session and a personal buoyancy aid (if required).*
