The programme flow for 7 Wonders of Gaya:

- 7:00am : Breakfast at Feast Village
- 8:00am : Meet our Resident Naturalist at Reception and depart to Proboscis Monkey platform
- 11:00am : Tavajun Bay to visit the Bearded Pigs and have lunch
- 2:45pm : Depart Tavajun Bay back to resort jetty
- 4:30pm : Tour designated resort areas to view remaining Wonders: Elephant Foot Yam, Red Giant Flying Squirrels, Twilight Fireflies and the Boobook Owl

*The timing for Mangrove Kayak Tour will vary depending on the tide level .*

## **CORAL GARDEN MARINE EXPEDITION**

Another wondrous world lies beneath the gentle waves of Tunku Abdul Rahman Marine Park. Explore the clear waters of the marine park guided by our Resident Marine Biologist. Drift over lush coral gardens and discover the wealth of marine life amidst an array of hard and soft coral that form intricate and fragile labyrinths across the seabed. *Inclusions: Guided tour, briefing on safety and snorkelling techniques, mask and snorkel, a debriefing session and a personal buoyancy aid (if required).*
